Dear customer

As part of the first time sewerage investigations at Sterndale Moor, we need to obtain ecological information in the area around Sterndale Moor.

How is it being done?

Severn Trent Water have appointed RPS Ecological Consultants to carry out an ecological desktop study report in the area around Sterndale Moor. The ecologist will also need to carry out a walk-over survey in the area shown overleaf in order to identify any invasive plant species, any ponds that may be suitable for great crested newts and other relevant information. The ecological walk-over survey may require access onto your land. The ecologist will carry ID confirmation. The survey work will be monitored by Severn Trent Water's Infrastructure and Planning Engineer, David Nightingale, who will attend site on the survey date.

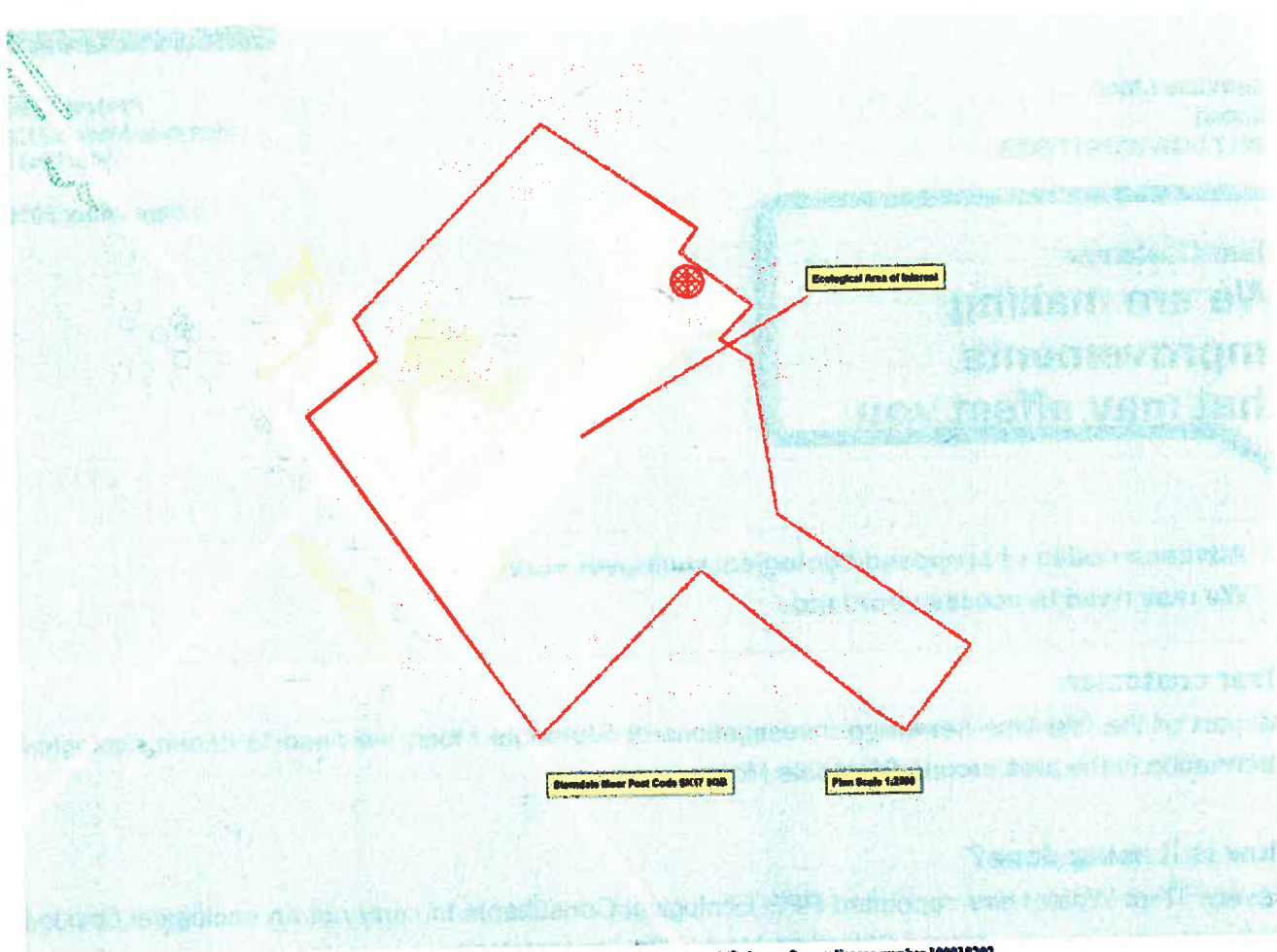
When will it happen?

RPS propose to carry out the ecological walk-over survey on **Tuesday 13 September 2016**. Your co-operation in allowing us to do this survey will be greatly appreciated.

It is not essential that you are at home whilst this work is carried out, but the ecologist will require any gates to be unlocked to enable a full survey to be undertaken. We appreciate that you may have some security concerns in leaving gates unlocked, so we would encourage you to leave any locked gate keys with a trusted neighbour. This work should cause minimal disruption and I request your co-operation to enable this work to be carried out. I apologise, in advance, for any inconvenience this work may cause.

Please Note: No-one will need to enter inside your building for this work to be carried out.
